


TWICE as NICE DICE




1. Print pages 2-6 pages on white card stock or thicker than normal paper that is at least 45-50 lb in weight. Staples has a great Professional Business paper by HP that is 48 lb and prints beautiful colors. Their basic card stock is 110 lb and works well, but colors aren't as vibrant. You'll also need a glue stick.

2. Score all 6 white-dotted fold lines on both of the dice before cutting. To score, you run the non-cutting side of a table knife along the edge of a ruler back and forth two or three times on the line to create a crease. This makes it easy to make neat folds exactly on the lines.




3. Cut out all items on the 4 pages of artwork, cutting on the edge of the color or just inside the black outlines.


4. Fold along all white dotted lines and make a clean crease by rubbing your thumbnail or the back of a table knife along the crease.



5. Glue one of the 8 pink squares to the non-printed back side of the 8 squares on each dice. They are a little smaller in both directions, so they should fit comfortably inside the fold lines. This will strengthen the dice, so they are sturdier and last longer.



6. Generously glue the printed side of the 4 pink flaps labeled A-D and attach them to the inside of all 4 red squares (no dots). Make sure you place glue on all corners and edges so they don't pop open. You should now have what you see in photo 6. Press on the inside and the outside of the box until the glue dries.



7. Put glue on the pink side of the remaining flap plus the inside of both of the red and white squares. Close the dice (with the pink flap inside and under the green and white square) and press the red and white squares onto the solid red squares, making sure they are straight before the glue dries. Press along all edges to make sure they are no open gaps.

8. Cut out the two cards and feel free to add a ribbon through two punch holes you can make in the top corners. Hang it somewhere for the whole family to see - so they are reminded of how important it is to be TWICE as NICE.
